

GOD'S BIG for the Hausa Land

he love of God personified in Christ Jesus is for all kindreds, tongues, people and nations (Revelation 5:9; 7:9).

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. (John 3:16-17)

Even before the coming of the White Missionaries into the Hausa Land, there was a prophecy about the coming of the missionaries who will lead people to Christ.

An Islamic cleric called Mallam Ibrahim Kano undertook a research on the person of Jesus (Isa) in the Quran and came to conclusion that Jesus is Greater than all the other prophets including Mohammed. He became more and more interested by the numerous references to Jesus in the Quran.

He then started a movement called the Isawa. This movement grew and attracted the attention of the Emir of Kano who invited Mallam Ibrahim Kano to explain these teachings of his. After hearing Mallam Ibrahim Kano he admonished him to stop, but he persisted. He was later killed in Kano on the order of the Emir of Kano.

Before the death of Mallam Ibrahim he told his adherents to flee to the boundaries of Kano, Zaria and Bauchi emirates to escape extermination. He also told them that God would reveal the true faith to them.

Later on, Yahaya took over the leadership of Isawa movement after Mallam Ibrahim Kano's death. He prophesied that strangers from the west would bring knowledge of the truth about the "Prophet Jesus" before he (Yahaya) died.

Even at the time of the Islamic rampage of the Hausa land by the Fulani jihadist of Usman Dan Fodio, God spoke to a group of Evangelical Students at Cambridge University who were persuaded that God was calling them to work among the Hausas.

This gave birth to what is known as the "Hausa Band" in 1891. The inception of the Hausa Band ignited the fire in the bones of the Christian Missionary Society (CMS) to prepare a small body for pioneering work in Hausaland.

In 1897, a small party including a medical student who recently qualified as a medical doctor by name Walter Miller was sent to study Hausa language in Tripoli, the capital of Libya.

Meanwhile little did this "Hausa Band" knew that as God was speaking to them, He was simultaneously preparing the ground for the gospel to come to the Hausa land by God revealing to an Islamic cleric called Mallam Ibrahim Kano that Jesus (Isa) was greater than all the prophets including Mohammed. He became more interested by the numerous references to Jesus in Quran and so he decided to undertake an intensive research.

After he came to the conclusion that Jesus is greater than all the prophets including Mohammed he started a "John the Baptist like ministry" movement to prepare the way for those whom God was specifically sending to the Hausa land as missionaries.

Even though he was killed by the then Emir of Kano. Yahaya took over the leadership of the Isawa Movement when they flee away from Kano. Interestingly before the dead of Yahaya (Mallam Ibrahim Kano's Successor) he prophesied to his followers that "strangers from the West would bring knowledge of the truth about the "Prophet Jesus".

Is God not wonderful? These Isawa people as said by Dr Walter Miller neither knew no Christians nor anything about the Christian religion, yet they were prophesying for the coming of these White people from Cambridge in the United Kingdom who will come and tell them the truth about Jesus Christ.

It is encouraging to know that God has special plans for the Hausa land. Ever since then, millions of Hausas have come to Christ and millions will still come.

Despite all the plans of Satan to truncate God's divine agenda for the Hausa land, the Church of Christ is still marching on against all odds.

Today to the Glory of God we make bold to say that there are millions of Indigenous Hausa Christians in Kaduna, Kano, Katsina, Zamfara, Sokoto, Kebbi, and many other places. But the growth and living the Christian life in the Hausa Land is with a severe price. The journey has been full of persecutions, killings, burnings and destructions of lives and properties, denial and infringement of our fundamental human rights, discriminations and intimidations.

The intensity of these persecutions increases as days go by. Life is unbearable for many people and it is full of uncertainties. Yet despite all these, many Hausas are still coming to Christ. Today there are Bishops, General Overseers, Pastors, Evangelists and Missionaries that are Hausas, who are not only doing the work of the ministry in Nigeria, but also taking the Gospel to the Hausas in other African Countries.

God's desire is not only for the Hausa land and its people to be saved, but to live the life he has given to us to the fullest.

...I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows). (John 10:10-AMP)

There are so many things which stand to hinder the plans of God for the Hausa Land and its people from coming to fulfillment. In furtherance of God's plans and purposes for the Hausa land especially now amidst the most challenging times of Christians in the Hausa Land and Northern Nigeria at large, God has raised a people for Himself with a definite assignment for His Glory.

THE BIRTH OF Vandate

he mandate of the Hausa Christians Foundation (HACFO) came as an instruction from God (Yahweh) to the Founder in what seems like in the order of God's call to Moses to liberate the children of Israelites from the bondage of the enemy.

The Lord spoke to the founder on 28th June, 2017 in very clear terms after experiencing and witnessing continuous acts of injustices, abuses and marginalization meted on the Northern Christians especially the Hausa Christians.

The Hausa Christians who many claimed that they don't even exist have suffered so many unjust treatments especially in the area of forceful abduction, Islamization, forced child marriage and sexual abuses of the young Hausa Christians Girls. The Lord gave this instruction to the Founder; "THIS IS THE TIME TO ACT, ACT NOW!"

Absolute conviction on the Lord's instruction and a simple act of obedience gave birth to the Hausa Christians Foundation. After forty days of acting on the Lord's instruction, the Lord honored His word and used the founder to champion the cause of the freedom of the first rescued victim.

The founder at the time of receiving the instruction from the Lord misinterpreted it to mean just to act and rescue the first victim, but her victory gave hope and boldness to many Christians in Northern Nigeria who began to open up and report issues that no one wouldn't have imagined that were happening in Nigeria.

While celebrating the victory of rescuing the first victim, two more girls were reported to us and the lord used the founder and other people who later joined him within a short time to rescue and reunite them back to their families.

The time HACFO started was not the time the instruction was given. The first instruction and the inception of HACFO came on Sunday 11th January, 2015 at about 2am, and the lord gave further clarity to the instruction on that same day at about 10am, (which really indicates the urgency of the assignment). HACFO officially started on Thursday 28th June, 2017 as it delivery date but the conception was on 11th June, 2015, two years earlier.

Ever since then, the Lord has been honoring and confirming His words with signs and wonders and astonishing victories. The more we continue to take each step of faith, the Lord was there to guide us and so the vision became clearer and bigger.

We started with the name; "Voice for the Emancipation of the Hausa Christians in Nigeria (VEHCIN) and later changed to Hausa Christians Foundation (HACFO) in the cause of our registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission of Nigeria.

As the vision became clearer, we understood the Lord leading us to base our focus on 5 key areas namely:

- 1. Christian Missions
- 2. Education and Empowerment Programs
- 3. Health and Human Services
- 4. Advocacy
- 5. Media



THE Mandate

PREAMBLE

he Hausa Christians Foundation (HACFO) is an indigenous **Mission Ministry** working among the Hausa People Group of Nigeria that has the mandate of God to lose the bands of wickedness, undo their heavy burdens, let the oppressed go free and break every yoke the Hausas are suffering from. We are called by God to raise the foundation of many generations, become the repairers of the breach and restore the paths to dwell in of the Hausa land. (Isaiah 58:6-14).

We are a Christ-centered Christian **Mission Ministry** that have become a voice for the emancipation of the Northern Christians especially the entire Hausa Christians Communities in Nigeria from all forms of religious or political harassments, marginalization and all manners of persecutions. We are out to advocate for equal rights and privileges both in the sphere of religion, politics and governance. We will continue to advocate for justice and actively resist all forms of abuse the Christian Communities have been subjected to simply for their faith in Christ Jesus. We will unite, encourage and motivate all the Northern Christians especially of the Hausa Decent to contend for their faith in Christ, pursue noble course and become more productive in their lives.

The essence of the entire mandate of the Hausa Christians Foundation is to encourage, equip and protect the Hausa Christians from the attacks of the wolves of this world, while we advance toward reaching the unsaved Hausas with the Gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to get them reconciled back to God.

We are anchored on the fact that God is a Triune Being; God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. Jesus is the Son of God, He died for the whole world, God raised Him from the dead and He is coming back again in Glory to receive us to Himself. We certainly know and believe that God is our Loving Father, Jesus is the way, the truth and the life and the Holy Spirit is our Helper and Comforter.

OUR VISION

To bring hope to our hopeless people, courage to the fearful, boldness to contend for our faith in Christ and rebuild the tenacity in the Hausa Christians in Nigeria to face the future without fear or doubt thereby raising as well as equipping men and women of the Hausa Christians for the work of the Ministry. In addition to reaching out to the Unreached Hausa People Group with the Gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

OUR PURPOSE

To liberate the oppressed Christians by especially becoming a voice for the emancipation of the Hausa Christians in Nigeria from all forms of marginalization and to equip them for the Master's Work thereby creating an enabling environment for the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ to reach the entire Hausa Land of Nigeria.

OUR MISSION

Reaffirming our existence, our origin, and our identity; advocating for justice and religious freedom and to mobilize a productive workforce and resources for Missions in the Hausa Land so we equip and protect the Hausa Christians as well as reach those Hausas that are not saved with the love and Gospel of Jesus Christ.

OUR CORE VALUES

- a) Fulfilling the Great Commission through Strategic Missions
- b) Setting the Captives Free from the Operations of the Devil through Mental and Spiritual Empowerment
- c) We anchored our entire activities on our faith in Christ Jesus as the Son of God and the Saviour of the World, and the supremacy of God's word over and above everything.
- d) We believe that all people are created equal irrespective of religion, gender or tribe, and so it is illegal to oppress any one. We hate injustice of whatever form
- e) We are committed to the cause of our freedom of worship, rights and privileges.
- f) We will not compromise our faith and vision due to pressure or pleasure.

THE HACFCY Activities

OUR ACTIVITIES ARE:

a) MISSIONS

Our Missions focus on uniting the Body of Christ in the Hausa Land, Bringing a powerful and lasting Revival of the Church in the Hausa Land, Perfecting the saints and winning more souls for Christ. We achieve this through Mission conferences, Mission outreaches, Mission Training and Missionary Services and Christian Literatures and Publications

b) EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMS

We believe in the power of education as a vital tool for the total development of humanity. We encourage our people to be properly educated, skillfully and economically empowered, and mentally liberated through our Schools Educational Programs and Outreaches, Empowerment Programs, Christian Religious Knowledge Support Programs, Enlightenment Programs and Research, History and Documentation.

c) HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES DIVISION

In our desire to see our people live a healthy and prosperous life, we organize Free Medical Outreaches and Primary Health Care Services, Health Education and Sensitization Programs and Rescued Victims Rehabilitation Programs.

d) ADVOCACY DIVISION

We see advocacy as a vital tool for restoring the dignity and freedom of our people. We speak and fight for those who cannot speak or fight for themselves. In our believe that all humans are created equal irrespective of tribe, gender or religion, we advocate for the upholding the sanctity of life, protection of fundamental human rights, religious freedom, girl child education and encourage peaceful coexistence and religious tolerance.

e) MEDIA DIVISION

Through media, we reach a wider audience with the Gospel of Christ, effectively enlighten the world on our programs. Our media comprises of units like Information Technology, Audio-Visuals, Info-graphics, and Publishing of edifying Christian literatures.



The TRUE-NORTH VISION OUTREACH Mandate

PREAMBLE

The mission strategy of the Hausa Christians Foundation (HACFO) mandate according to Act 1:8 is that the Hausa Land is our Jerusalem, Northern Nigeria our Judea, Nigeria our Samaria and Africa and the Whole World is our the outermost part of the world.

The **True-North Vision Outreach** is therefore the Judea phase of the HACFO mandate to preach the Gospel of the kingdom to the entire Northern Nigeria.



The time to bring the entire region of Northern Nigeria to Zion is now.

We are commissioned by God to breeding world-changers, mountain movers and Kingdom giants from the Northern States of Nigeria.

As long as we are in Nigeria, we will not condone any form of injustice against us just because we are Christians. We will never be silent again. We will always TELL the TRUTH at ALL COST, and keep SHINING the LIGHT.

In Northern Nigeria today, the Hausa Christians consider themselves as the epitome of what the scriptures says in 2 Corinthians 4:8-14

We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body. For we who are alive are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that his life may be revealed in our mortal body. So then, death is at work in us, but life is at work in you.

It is written: "I believed; therefore I have spoken." With that same spirit of faith we also believe and therefore speak, because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead will also raise us with Jesus and present us with you in his presence.



THE HACFO STRUCTURE

PREAMBLE

The Necessity of the Ministerial Assignments should determine our level of involvement and commitment and not we determining how and when the assignment should be carried out at our wish. Every Kingdom Labourer must see Himself or Herself as a Soldier and a Soldier works with commands. He or she does the commanded and not the convenient.

The general workforce of the Hausa Christians Foundation (HACFO) shall be called the Harvest Team which shall comprise of the following categories of labour force:

- 1. HACFO Ministerial Board
- 2. HACFO Dream Team
- 3. HACFO Launch Team
- 4. HACFO volunteers Network.
- 5. HACFO Global Kingdom Partners Network

1) HACFO MINISTERIAL BOARD (THE 12)

These are full time tasted, trained, proven and faithful staff who shall be tasked with decrees and policies formation of the Hausa Christians Foundation. They are a team of people of undying passion for the fulfillment of the HACFO Mandate and people of unquestionable character and loyalty. They are the team that will be trusted with the deep things of God and the mystery of the kingdom as well as HACFO. They are the emblem of the 12 disciples of Jesus in HACFO.

- · They shall be full time and paid staff.
- · They shall be entrusted with deep things of God and the ministry of the kingdom (ministry of HACFO).
- · They are the 12 of the NT and the sons of the prophet of the OT
- They will be saddled and be committed to the ministry of the word and prayers. Taking the Gospel to the ends of the earth is their primary mandate through all means possible.
- · They are to be with the founder just as Jesus's disciples were with Him always
- · They are to act and behave like the founder as he follows Christ.
- · They are to be a testament of Christ and the founder to others.

OFFICES OF THE HACFO MINISTERIAL BOARD INCLUDES;

- a) Director Missions
- b) Director Advocacy
- c) Director Education and Empowerment programs
- d) Director Health and Human services
- e) Director Media
- f) Director Operations
- g) State Directors.

OUT OF THE TWELVE SHALL COME THE 3

- · The 3 are Peter, James and John and they were Jesus' confidants
- · They acted as Jesus personal assistance
- · They carried out instructions for Jesus
- · They were privileged to experience what others could not.
- · They hold the responsibilities of taking care of the rest.

These 3 shall be the top (senior management) staff of the ministry

They shall be appointed into the following offices base on performances, unquestionable character, loyalty and proven spiritual maturity.

- a) National Director, HACFO
- b) National Director, True-North Vision Outreach
- c) Senior Assistant Lead minister

They could be appointed as the Missioners of the Lead minister and the HACFO Commission.

THE HACFO STRUCTURE

CONDITIONS FOR ENLISTMENT IN THE 12

- 1. Must have serve HACFO for a minimum of 2 years with proven track records
- 2. Successfully completed HACFO School of Missions fully paid by him or her
- 3. Successfully completed 1 year Missionary Internship Program
- 4. After two years of serving such a person will be enrolled in Rhema Bible training center Nigeria. (Payment of tuition fee will be 50/50) and also be willing to attend any further necessary training
- 5. While fully engaged, remuneration will be clearly defined.
- 6. Must have a proven call into full time ministry
- 7. While enrolled in the 12, such a person shall work under one of the 12s for a period of 2 years.
- 8. One has to be sure and willing to serve and remain in HACFO for at least 10 years to be part of the 12.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENT INTO THE 12 FULL TIME MINISTRY.

- 1. Must have outstanding service records of spiritual impact
- 2. Must have godly character with exemplary lifestyle
- 3. Must have unquestionable loyalty and an embodiment of the cultures of HACFO.
- 4. Must visibly carry the spirit of the HACFO Commission.
- 5. Must be physically and mentally fit.
- 6. Must have a minimum of 2 years of unbroken and productive voluntary service in HACFO
- 7. While appointment as a Missioner is the prerogative of the Lead Minister, it shall require the ratification of the BOT and the 3
- 8. Must serve in acting capacity of the office he or she is to occupy for 2 years before the full appoint in full capacity is ratified

2) THE HACFO DREAM TEAM (Ministry Team)

These are full time skilled employed staff in different disciplines necessary for the day to day running of the ministry. They will be saddled with the administrative and execution of the HACFO goals. They will be working in the HACFO mission House daily. They are also paid staff, which shall be answerable the HACFO Ministerial Board (the 12) These offices shall be but not limited to the following.

- a) I.T and web Admin
- b) Videographer/photographer
- c) Graphics designer
- d) Hausa translator
- e) Admin/finances/human resource
- f) Partners services
- g) Audio producer/sound engineer
- h) Video editor
- i) Personal secretary to the lead minister / mandate secretary
- j) Securities
- k) Office assistant / janitor
- Project monitory secretary

3) HACFO LAUNCH TEAM (THE 70)

The Launch Team are Tentmakers Missionaries who carryout other personally related functions (work in other places) but using the same opportunity to spread the Gospel of the kingdom. They are part time staff of HACFO whose primary functions included but not limited to the following;

- They are the help ministers
- Helping the 12 in implementation
- They form the state staff of HACFO
- · They are labourers, service man and women both professionally and skillfully
- · These set of people use their skills to carry out missions work in some very difficult missions' fields.
- They use their skills to find opportunities for the gospel
- A Tentmaker is a dedicated, spiritually matured Christian man or woman who views work in light of the Great commission as an opportunity to serve the kingdom of God.
- Tent makers are part time staff of HACFO and they are also non paid staff.

4) HACFO VOLUNTEER'S NETWORK

These are matured and mission minded Christians who believe in the mandate of HACFO and are willing to volunteer their services to achieve a particular goal. Their services are employed as occasion demands. They could serve in different capacities as need arise.

- 480+ Youths attended our Northwest and North Central Youths Summit that took place at Malumfashi Katsina State and Lafia Nassarawa State respectively.
- 5000+ Were reached with the Gospel through our Mission Outreaches in Kaduna, Kano, Katsina, Zamfara and Jigawa States.
- 670 People rededicated their lives and accept Jesus as their Lord and Personal Saviour.
- 28 New Believers came to Christianity from Islam. We have sponsored some to Discipleship Training School in Jos and some supported to remain stable in their faith despite the persecutions.
- Over 180 people were healed of several diseases and delivered of demonic oppressions during our outreaches and conferences.
- We have distributed 500+ Hausa Bibles and Hausa Hymnbooks in the cause of our outreaches
- 65 people were trained in Sogiji, Sabon Gari LGA of Kaduna State in our Hausa Literacy Program, to know how to read and write in Hausa Language with the sole aim of them knowing how to read Hausa Bibles
- 130 Families of Martyred, Deceased, Retired and Active Pastors and Missionaries in the Hausa land and some parts of Northern Nigeria were supported with food items, clothes, school fees and medical bills.
- Out of the 4 mission fields we are trusting God to build churches, we have successfully built and roofed one with the capacity of 100 seats.
