THE MANDATE OF THE HAUSA CHRISTIANS FOUNDATION (HACFO)

THE BIRTH OF THE HACFO MANDATE

The mandate of the Hausa Christians Foundation (HACFO) came as an instruction from God (Yahweh) to the Founder in what seems like in the order of God's call to Moses to liberate the children of Israelites from the bondage of the enemy. The Lord spoke to the founder on 28th June, 2018 in very clear terms after experiencing and witnessing continuous acts of injustices, abuses and marginalization meted on the Northern Christians especially the Hausa Christians. The Hausa Christians who many claimed that they don't even exist have suffered so many unjust treatments especially in the area of forceful abduction, Islamization, child marriage and sexual abuses of the young Hausa Christians Girls. The Lord gave this instruction to the Founder; "THIS IS THE TIME TO ACT, ACT NOW!" Absolute conviction on the Lord's instruction and a simple act of obedience gave birth to the Hausa Christians Foundation. After forty days of acting on the Lord's instruction, the Lord honored His word and used the founder to champion the cause of the freedom of the first victim. The founder at the time of receiving the instruction from the Lord misinterpreted it to mean just to act and rescue the first victim, but her victory gave hope and boldness to many Christians in Northern Nigeria who began to open up and report issues that no one would have imagined that were happening in Nigeria. While celebrating the victory of rescuing the first victim, two more girls were reported to us and the lord used the founder and other people who later joined him within a short time to rescue and reunite them back to their families.

Ever since then, the Lord has been honoring and confirming His words with signs and wonders and astonishing victories. The more we continue to take each step of faith, the Lord was there to guide us and so the vision became clearer and bigger. We started with the name; "Voice for the Emancipation of the Hausa Christians in Nigeria (VEHCIN) and later changed to Hausa Christians Foundation (HACFO) in the cause of our registration with the Corporate Affairs Commission of Nigeria.

As the vision became clearer, we understood the Lord leading us to base our focus on 5 key areas namely:

- 2. Education and Empowerment Programs

- 3. Health and Human Services
- 4. Advocacy
- 5. Media

THE HACFO MANDATES

The Hausa Christians Foundation (HACFO) is an indigenous **Mission Ministry** working among the Hausa People Group of Nigeria that has the mandate of God to lose the bands of wickedness, undo their heavy burdens, let the oppressed go free and break every yoke the Hausas are suffering from. We are called by God to raise the foundation of many generations, become the repairers of the breach and restore the paths to dwell in of the Hausa land. (Isaiah 58:6-14).

We are a Christ-centered Christian **Mission Ministry** that have become a voice for the emancipation of the Northern Christians especially the entire Hausa Christians Communities in Nigeria from all forms of religious or political harassments, marginalization and all manners of persecutions. We are out to advocate for equal rights and privileges both in the sphere of religion, politics and governance. We will continue to advocate for justice and actively resist all forms of abuse the Christian Communities have been subjected to simply for their faith in Christ Jesus. We will unite, encourage and motivate all the Northern Christians especially of the Hausa Decent to contend for their faith in Christ, pursue noble course and become more productive in their lives.

The essence of the entire mandate of the Hausa Christians Foundation is to encourage, equip and protect the Hausa Christians from the attacks of the wolves of this world, while we advance toward reaching the unsaved Hausas with the Gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to get them reconciled back to God.

We are anchored on the fact that God is a Triune Being; God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. Jesus is the Son of God, He died for the whole world, God raised Him from the dead and He is coming back again in Glory to receive us to Himself. carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body. For we who are alive are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that his life may be revealed in our mortal body. So then, death is at work in us, but life is at work in you.

It is written: "I believed; therefore I have spoken." With that same spirit of faith we also believe and therefore speak, because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead will also raise us with Jesus and present us with you in his presence.

THE PLIGHTS, THE BLIGHTS AND THE PERILS OF THE HAUSA CHRISTIANS IN NIGERIA

he Non-Muslim Hausa have been victims of so many abuses and maltreatments since the emergence of Islamic system of ruling in Northern Nigeria. Hausa being a tribe and not a religion has lost its original meaning to mean different things to so many people locally and internationally. The word Hausa has been abused to be like another kind of Islamic Religion. Whenever the word Hausa is mentioned the first things that usually come to the minds of many people around the world are Islamic militants, jihadists, terrorists, persecutors of the Church in Nigeria, workers of iniquity and all sorts of things. Funny enough, whenever an Easterner, Southerner or Westerner

becomes a Muslim and is living in the Northern Nigeria, such a person will be claiming to be a Hausa person. It is very common to see many people that are not Hausas to be referring to themselves as Hausas simply because they have become Muslims. And so, when the Southerners, Westerners, and Easterners will refer to the Muslims in the North they always call them Hausa People. Or whenever you hear them said Hausa People, what they actually meant to say is Northern Muslims. Interestingly, there are many indigenous northern tribes in the North apart from Hausa that are living in all the Northern States of Nigeria, but they are all also referred to as Hausa People not to mean that their tribe is Hausa but to mean that they are Muslims.

And so, terms like Hausa, Arewa and Hausa-Fulani are nothing but the impersonation of the Northern Muslims. In the long standing deception, buried are the freedoms and destinies of so many indigenous Northern Christians especially the Hausa Christians in Nigeria.

We have been turn down to worse than second class citizens in our country because we are Christians. We have endured all forms of slavery even in the 21st Century. Many are the afflictions of the Hausa Christians in Nigeria, but below are the most pronounced ones:

 A deliberate denial of the existence of the Hausa Christians in Northern Nigeria; deceiving the world that all Hausas are Muslims except a very few that practice paganism which they usually refer to as the



Maguzawas. The claim that all Hausas are Muslims has caged and denied the identity, rights and privileges of the Hausa Christians in Nigeria. It has given birth to the genesis and the continuous slavery the Hausa and Northern Christians have been subjected to.

- 2. Denying the Children of the Hausa Christians schools admission, Certificate of Indigenization and employment into all the public offices in the Country especially those with Christian or English Names.
- 3. Use of slight opportunity to cause riots that always result in the burning of our houses, churches, looting of all our valuables, raping our women as well as killing our men and women.
- Intentional burning down of our Churches and deliberately refusing the Churches permission to be rebuilt by the government.
- 5. Forceful kidnapping, raping and conversion of our young Hausa Christian girls into Islam against their wish, denying their parents access to them, marry them and giving them out in marriage to whosoever they wish against the wish of their parents.
- The settlements of the Hausa Christians are incapacitated by bad roads; lack of healthcare facilities, electricity, portable drinking water and any form of social amenities as dividends of democracy from our governments.
- Denial of our people the right to participate in politics and governance by deliberately preventing our





- settlements from having polling units prevention of any Hausa Christian to hold any traditional or political office in the Northern states of Nigeria, even though we have highly educated people, but caged down by the unjust treatments of the Hausa Muslims in the Nigerian Government.
- 8. A current trend that is engulfing the entire Hausa Christians Settlements is the issue of ceasing our farm lands and even our settlements that our people have stayed in for hundreds of years by these so-called Traditional rulers. Many of our people are losing their farm lands which are the major sources of the livelihood of the Hausa Christians.
- 9. The Northern Christians have been forcefully silenced in a system called Arewa. A system or an Islamic agenda of using States and Federal Resources to advance the cause of Islam in Northern Nigeria to the detriment of all the Non-Muslims in northern Nigeria through the subduing of the indigenous Christians by the use of all forms of terror. This system is in a deep and strong anarchy with freedom. Arewa has forcefully become an Islamic region where the truth is very scarce and even telling the truth can cost a person his or her life.
- 10. The security of our lives and properties are in complete shambles. The Hausa Christians are not only suffering from lack of basic social amenities like roads, portable water, electricity, schools, primary healthcare facilities but also lack of security of their lives and properties. Many of the Hausa Christians are always robbed by arm robbers, their men and wives kidnapped and released on huge ransom. The Hausa Christians are living like hopeless orphans in their own country with only God to help simply because they are Christians.

- 11. Deliberate refusal of the Northern States Government to employ Christian Religious Knowledge (CRK) Teachers in both the Primary and Secondary schools in Zamfara, Kano, Katsina, Sokoto, Kaduna, Kebbi, Jigawa states and other states, while Islamic Religious Knowledge Teachers are employed and paid in all the schools by the same States Government. Denying the few Christian Students in the Government Boarding and day Schools the right to fellowship or do any Christian activities on Sundays and other days. Practical example is GGCTalatan Mafara.
- Refusing any Christian representatives that can protect the interest of the Indigenous Christians in the Ministry for Religious Affairs of States like Zamfara, Sokoto, Kano, Katsina, Jigawa etc.
- 13. Disconnection of electric power supply from all the Churches in Zamfara State and even denying the Church the bill to pay at the electric Authority offices. While the mosques receive power supply free of charge and without any disconnection. According to the Electric Supply Authority of the state, that it is now a new law to disconnect Churches from using the light. ECWA Church Damba and other churches are victims of this discrimination.
- 14. The Christian Burial Ground (Cemetery) in Zamfara State that has been in existence for more than 40 years is now filled up, but the Government have refused to allocate more spaces to the Christians to bury their people. That's how the Christians are still squeezing in those who died in that same cemetery.
- 15. The Christians in Zamfara, Sokoto, Kano, Katsina State and other states have been banned from airing any Christian Program in the Radio Station while the Muslims do that every day.

There are several capacities conferences, and trainings for the staff but money has been the major hindrances. Pray for God to raise His People to Partner with us for the
- 5. We have human forces that have become tools in the hands of the enemy who move around to discredit and sabotage our efforts. The persecutions, harassments and attacks of all forms are increasing. Pray for the Grace for continuity, focus and vigilance.

Works at hand

- 6. Movement to our various mission fields is becoming difficult due to lack of mobility. The car we have been using which belongs to our Founder is now not in good condition due to accidents and the distance it covered mostly in damaged or rural roads for almost two years. The engine is failing, the body is becoming weaker and the maintenance is getting higher every day. We are in dire need of a truck and a bus. Pray for Divine Provision.
- 7. Partnership drive is a necessity, since the mission work is run solely from the support of our partners. The harvest is ripe and plentiful but the labourers and resources are very limited. We could not do much due to lack of finance. Pray for God to bless our Partners more and to also raise more Partners for this work.
- 8. Our operational headquarters is too small to accommodate all the activities of HACFO and so the need for a better bigger place. But operating from a rented facility is not sustainable in the long run and so the need for the proposals for a bigger permanent place for HACFO operations. We are trusting God to begin to work in that direction in 2019 as God opens more doors of His Blessings to us all. **Pray for God to grant us a huge success in this Project.**
- 9. We have 15 committed staff who are mostly working with

- little or no allowance (Transport and Feeding). As they have abandoned their personal works to serve God through HACFO, we are trusting God to encouragement them with at least a basic salary to meet their basic needs. **Pray for More Open Doors to Support our Staff Welfare.**
- 10. Indigenous Minsters/Pastors are retiring every year but there are no replacements due to fear of the unknown and poor welfare treatment of Ministers in the Hausa Land. Pray for God to send more labourers into the Harvest Field of the entire Hausa Land and to raise more Passionate Hausa Ministers and missionaries who will take over from those who have retired. Pray for the Boldness to preach the Gospel in the Hausa land.
- 11. There is a thick darkness hovering upon the Hausa Land. Ignorance, fear, slavery and evil practices have taken hold of the affairs of the Hausa Land. Pray for the salvation of the entire Hausa land that the thick veil of Darkness be lifted up from the entire Hausa Land of Nigeria; and the light of the Glorious Gospel of Christ to Shine on the entire Hausa Land and for the supernatural revelation of the saving

Power of Christ regardless of the human boundaries set in place.

THE HAUSA PEOPLE GROUP

- There are 3 major belief systems among the Hausa People Group of Nigeria: Christianity, Islam and Animism (maguzanci)
- There are over 20 million Hausas in Nigeria that have not been reached with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. About 60% of these people have never had any contact with any kind of Christian missionary.
- The Hausa land is ripe for a great harvest of souls yet hundreds of them are dying and perishing every day, because only few Christians are willing to reach out to them and tell them about the love of Jesus Christ.
- Many unbelievers in the Hausa land want to come to Christ but the fear of losing their lives is preventing them, and very few Christians are ready and willing to welcome them when they receive Christ.
- The intensity of the persecution the Christians in Northern Nigeria, especially the Hausa Christians are passing through is increasing by the day. Hardships and pains are becoming the order of the day and life is becoming meaningless and hopeless for many.
- The Christians are losing their lives and properties on a daily basis. New converts are at the risk of losing their lives or being subjected to a severe torture until they denounce Christ.
- The Hausa Land is too hostile toward any form of Christian activities.

IT IS POSSIBLE

- When God gives us a mission to the 6,698 Unreached People Groups (UPGs), He gives PROVISION for the MISSION!
- In every blessing is a seed of mission.
- Whenever we are blessed we have a divine obligation to be a blessing.
- It is not the will of God, that any Hausa man or woman should perish, but everyone should come to repentance (2 peter 3:9)
- Our life on this earth is only a blip in time. We do not seek false safety and fabricated security. Glorifying God should be our purpose. In the end of life on earth we hope to hear, "Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master" (Matthew 25:21).







(A SPECIAL MISSION REPORT OF THE JIGAWA STATE 2018 MISSION OUTREACH CONDUCTED BY THE HAUSA CHRISTIANS FOUNDATION (HACFO) NIGERIA IN PARTNERSHIP WITH HASKEN RAYUWA AFRIKA MINISTRY, NIGERIA FROM: 5TH TO 7TH DECEMBER, 2018)

It was a phenomenal experience for both the Hausa Christians Foundation (HACFO) and Hasken Rayuwa Afrika Ministry during the 3 days joint mission outreach to Roni, Jigawa State, Nigeria. We were excited to minister the Word and the Love of Jesus Christ as a way of encouraging, edifying and empowering the Hausa Christians of Jigawa to remain strong, steadfast and committed to their faith in Christ Jesus and the work of mission in the Hausa Land. We were overwhelmed at the kind of the reception we received, and the keen interest in listening to our teachings and ministrations throughout the sessions. They remained attentive and receptive of what God laid in our hearts to minister in those three days. We thought we were there to just minister, but we ended up been ministered, encouraged and challenged at the same time. The 3 days mission outreach took a new turn in the last session of the program. It was a moment of heaviness for us all that were there. After the last teaching session, we gave our hosts a time to share testimonies of how the Lord has blessed them during our stay with them for the three days; that was how everybody broke silence.

We misunderstood the smiles in their faces, their zeal to serve God and their resolute to serve God to mean that all is well with most of them. At this point, we received the strangest revelation of why God sent us to those places on a mission. In that last session, we got to understand in reality the kind of people we were ministering to. They are people who have paid a huge price, some with even their lives for them to remain in Christ and for Christianity to survive to this time. Most of them had heartbreaking stories, which could not even be uttered without tears from both our eyes. Some were disowned by their parents, some were driven away to perish, some were thrown into a well to die there but they survived it, while some were denied their inheritance and their belongings, all for the sake of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We were humbled by the

level of the stigmatization and marginalization that almost all of them endured for more than 40, 50 and even 60 years and above simply for their choice to follow Christ. Without having a firsthand experience or information with evidence of what we saw, it will be literarily impossible for many people to believe what the Northern Christians of Nigeria especially the Hausa Christians are going through at the moment.

What could be more painful than becoming an outcast, or an orphan not because your parents are dead, or your brothers and sisters are dead nor because of any crime you committed but because of your choice to believe and follow Christ. They went through severe pains of physical and psychological torture, but still love those who have treated them unjustly.

With tears running down their eyes, we hear them begging us to pray for their parents, brothers and sisters who are yet to come to Christ. We won't forget these words "Please, we need your prayers, our brothers and sisters are dying without coming to Christ, please join us to pray so that they won't perish. We are highly blessed and encouraged by your coming. We don't use to have such opportunities, please come again." We literarily saw the love of Christ in them, passionately praying for the salvation of those who kill them, reject them, and deny them their legitimate sources of livelihood. Some stories are heavy to say, and difficult to believe without seeing it.

After this life-changing experience, our eyes were opened to the numerous privileges that many Christians are having especially those in southern part of Nigeria but some are abusing it. These are Christians that many people thought don't even exist, they live every day in rejection and persecution yet, they are living and moving on with the Gospel against all odds. It takes a sincere heart of love to pray for your enemy and to still love him or her with the God-kind of Love.

This experience does not require emotional sympathy only, but it has reignited our hearts to go further with the love and the Gospel of Jesus Christ to save the world from destruction and entanglement of the enemy. Love is what is required to reach the world for Christ. Time is fast moving but there are so much more harvests to be done.

We therefore request of every Christian in Nigeria especially from the South to do the following for the Christians of Jigawa State and Northern Nigeria in general:

- 1. Pray for the Grace to continue and finish this race strong
- 2. Pray for the salvation of our Brothers and Sisters who are yet to come to the love and saving power of Jesus Christ.
- Pray and take authority over every veil of darkness that has covered their eyes from seeing the way of Christ to be lifted up.
- Send all manners of help for the persecuted Christians in those places (Eg. Bibles, Educational and Learning Materials, Clothing, Food, Health Facilities, scholarships etc.)

Father, who has made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who has delivered us from the power of darkness, and has translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: in whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins.

We will never cease to thank God for making salvation through Christ Jesus to be free for every nation, tribe and kindred. Despite the fact that many have tried and are still trying so hard to deny the Hausa People Group access to this great opportunity of eternal life, the Gospel, which is the power of God unto salvation, is on a daily basis breaking every form of tribal, ethnic and social barriers. Thank God that the Love of God in Jesus Christ is also for the Hausa People Group.

We cannot underestimate the powerful roles that our parents played in ensuring the spread of the Gospel of Jesus Christ in the Hausa Land against all odds; many of which were disowned, jailed, tortured and even killed for their faith in Christ. The propaganda that is being sponsored to deceive the world that there are no Hausas that are Christians in Nigeria and even beyond is suffering a severe defeat on a daily basis. Today, to the Glory of God and to the shame of the devil, we make bold to say that there are millions of Hausa Christians in Nigeria and other African Countries.

Although the work is moving on, there

is however a rising concern that needs urgent interventions for the work of the preaching of the Good News of the Kingdom to be sustained. Many of the indigenous people that God used to continue with the work of evangelizing the Hausa Land after the Western Missionaries had left are people that were passionately consumed by their callings to reach to others for Christ immediately after being saved. Most of them had no any formal education except the little they received as a short term training to prepare them for the work that God has called them to. Out of the passion to bring many to Christ, many of them abandoned their homes and whatever they had and surrendered their lives totally to Christ. Some died in the process while some became too old to continue and so they had to retire. The support or the stipends that most of these indigenous missionaries received while in service has never been able to feed their family let alone send the children to school. Many of them lived their lives without proper medical assistance, healthy food or something to secure the future of their children. Even with that, life in Ministry despite all the internal and external challenges is more hopeful to them than life after ministry. The most terrible nightmare in the lives of many of our indigenous pastors and missionaries is knowing that one day they will all retire and go back home. What will they go back home and face? Is it the rejection from their extended or immediate families who are not Christians or the pain of thinking of

where to start? Is it the house to stay or the food to eat or even the medical bills after retirement?

It is God who has called them into the work, and so, it won't be godly to watch them after serving God faithfully to end up as hopeless as anyone who has no God or brothers and sisters to help them. Their children who are somewhat victims of circumstances live with resentment and hatred toward the Church when they look at how their parents end after serving God. It is not common to see the children of these pastors and missionaries doing any form of ministry just because of how life treated their parents. The fear of becoming wretched and helpless is now preventing many young people in the Hausa land from taking over from these our God's generals who cannot longer continue due to their advancement in age. We have many people who are retiring from Ministry every year, but very few to take over from them.

The lives of these retired ministers who have served God diligently; who have risked their lives and sustained the Gospel in the Hausa Land is in such a pathetic state. Some are sick with no money for treatment, some are struggling on how to survive with no certainty of the next meal, some are living without a house, and some continue to suffer the rejections they faced all their lives and pray for nothing more than for God to take them home.





In our mission outreaches we have come across so many of these people who obviously need all manners of help, encouragement and love for them to finish well. At this time nothing will strengthen their faith than knowing that someone somewhere cares for them; nothing will give them peace like knowing that somebody appreciates their service unto God. They have poured out their lives as living offerings, they have fought the good fight of faith, they have brought many to Christ, but they are left in their old age with no one to cater for them. The strength to go out and find another job to sustain them is no longer there. That is how many of them live their lives, but it should not be so.

What these people need is not something big, a gift of just N5,000.00, or N10,000.00 a month or quarterly can turn their hopeless situations around. They don't receive even gratuity or pensions from most of the ministries in which they served. Just

kind gestures from the Christians can bring back hope in the lives of many of them.

For the Gospel to be sustained in the Hausa Land and for the lost to be saved, the Church must be strategically proactive in all its approaches. We must not create any loophole for the enemy to gain ground into destroying the work that God has already started. We must inspire the upcoming generations by helping the older generation who have served God well to go home in peace knowing fully well that their labour is not in vain.

As we commit ourselves to the course of reaching out to the entire Hausa Land by perfecting the saints and saving the lost, will you help us bless at least a life by becoming our partner today?
